

These are the set up directions to properly run the Auto Genius program using Windows 95, 98, and ME. Access to these files can be obtained by clicking on the start button, selecting run and typing SYSEDIT. After the changes are made the system will need to be rebooted.

Autoexec.bat should contain the following

```
PATH C:\WINDOWS;C:\WINDOWS\COMMAND;\ARJ;\FOX
DEL C:\RUNNING
SET USERID=Tx
```

(Please note x = terminal number and must be unique on each computer.

For example:
SET USERID=T1

```
del \work\dbf1\*. > c:\null
DEL \WORK\SEARCH\*. > C:\NULL
```

ONLY ON SERVER
ADD THESE 2 LINES

DO NOT TYPE .*
JUST ONE "*"

cls
echo Loading Operating System ...
```

Config.sys should contain the following:

```
DEVICE=C:\WINDOWS\HIMEM.SYS
FILES=60
BUFFERS=16
```

SYSTEM.INI should be modified to include the following:

At then end of [386Enh] the section add this:
PerVMFiles=75

After the [386Enh] add the following new sections:

```
[NETWORK]
PRINTBUFTIME=2
```

```
[IFSMGR]
PRINTBUFTIME=2
```
